

Major College Football Division - 100

The 20 Cupcakes

The [Major College Football Division](#) is based on the [S.A.F. E. Philosophy](#) and the [No Cupcake Rule](#) which require every Conference and Team to have Fair treatment and an Equal status in the Division assuring that every School has an Equal chance to play for the National Championship and no team or Conference is a Cupcake.

The 2016 Regular Season of the NCAA Division 1 FBS features 128* teams with unequal status in 10 Conferences of unequal status, size and strength of programs. This will be fixed by the Perfect Playoff Plan 16 that will reorganize the FBS into a new football only Major College Football Division with the 100 strongest teams in 10 Conferences with Equal Status, Size and Strength of Programs. This requires a consolidation that drops the weakest 38 teams. Dropping the [9 former FCS](#) teams added since 2012 because of the [No Patsy Rule](#), and the 20 Cupcakes (*) with the weakest records overall.

Below is a chart of the 20 Cupcakes from the former Group of Five Conferences with their Regular Season wins percentage over the last 8 years in the first box and the 19 years since the BCS in the second box.
