

THE PERFECT PLAYOFF PLAN

16 Team - National Championship Playoff Series

Due to the continued controversy over the lack of an NCAA Division I-A FBS National Championship and dissatisfaction with the BCS system for choosing their National Champion, in June of 2012 the BCS and its 11 Conferences & Notre Dame capitulated and approved a Playoff, but with only 4 Teams chosen by a committee. ([Compare to the NFL & FCS](#))

In light of the now heightened discontent inspired by the College Football Playoff's (CFP) weak 4 team proposal, giving us more of the same from the former BCS, a new Playoff Plan is needed. (see [Chart of Questions Answered](#)) This replacement Playoff does not respond to the complaints from both those that wanted the old BCS nor those that want a comprehensive solution that will give us an [Undisputed National Champion](#).

This **PERFECT PLAYOFF PLAN** for a 16 Team National Championship Playoff answers all the fears of the pro BCS hold outs while giving the Playoff Proponents the solution to all the ills of the CFP. The plan returns responsibility to the NCAA and its Schools to ensure that a [S.A.F.E.](#) Philosophy is applied to putting the Student and Academics first, while being Fair to every Football Program and establishing Equality among the Conferences with this **Reorganization**.

Reforms the Div 1 FBS by making it into a new Major College Football Division (MCFD) with a 16 Team National Championship Playoff administered by the NCAA with the authority of its MCFD member Schools. And a [No Patsy Rule](#) ending the scheduling of a 12th game with lower division opponents to pad a team's winning record. Also ending the distinction of Power Five Conferences and teams labeled as a [Cupcake](#) and the Independent Status of some Schools.

Restructures the 128 team FBS into a new Football Only 100 team [Major College Football Division](#) divided into 10 equal strength and status Conferences of 10 teams each. Reducing the Regular Season to 11 games over 12 weeks ending the Saturday after Thanksgiving. Replacing the 4 team [Failed CFP](#) with a 16 Team National Championship Playoff made up of the 10 Conference Champions and the 6 Second Place Teams with the most wins in a 4 Round Playoff beginning with 8 on-site home games in Round 1 on the 1st Saturday in December. Followed by the Round 2 Quarter-Finals with 4 Bowl Games on the 3rd Saturday. Then the Round 3 Semi-Finals on the 5th Saturday of December or 1st Saturday of January when before the 5th. Finally the Round 4 National Championship Game played on the first Saturday after January 4th. (See the [National Championship Playoff Series](#) & [Post Season Bowl Competition](#))

Realigns the Conferences to reflect regional groupings and traditional membership while fairly dividing programs into equal strength Conferences. (See [Conference Realignment](#))
