Home Game Schedule Rules

The Perfect Playoff Plan is built on the [SAFE](#) Philosophy of Students and Academics first and Fair and Equal treatment for all Teams & Conferences. That means [No Patsy](#) opponents and [No Cupcake](#) status for any Team or Conference resulting in a reduction to an 11 game Regular Season over 12 weeks. The result is a reduction in Home Games by 1 or 2 for most Teams to achieve a maximum of 6 home games for the 45 Group 1 teams.

During the 2016 Regular Season the 90 teams included in the Major College Football Division had 41 teams that played 7 home games and 2 teams with 8 home games that will result in these 43 teams losing 1 or 2 home games under the max 6 home game rule of the Perfect Playoff Plan. But the benefits of not playing a 12th Regular Season game against an FCS Patsy team or a weak Cupcake team out-weigh 1 or 2 fewer home games.

The Perfect Playoff Plan's [Major College Football Division \(MCFD\)](#) with 90 teams is designed to make every Regular Season game count towards winning a place in the 16 Team [National Championship Playoff Series \(NCPS\)](#). So the rule that every team will play 4 Conference home and away games each season is necessary to insure that every team has the same chance to win the Championship. No polls, computers or committees allowed, because they caused the [College Football Playoff to Fail](#). Likewise making Conferences equal in status, size and strength is the reason that winning the Conference Championship is the only achievement required to get into the Playoff. Having a 16 Team playoff gives 6 teams a second chance to get into the Playoff. All 10 Second Place teams have an Equal chance to win one of the final 6 spots by simply winning more games than 4 of the others. The 45 Group 1 teams will play 4 Home Conference games and 2 Home and Away Non Conference series against Group 1 & 2 teams and 1 Home Non Conference game against the Group 2 or 3 teams for their 6 Home game [Regular Season Schedule](#).

The Home Game Schedule Rules are an important Equalizing factor in making the 16 team Perfect Playoff Plan successful at determining an [Undisputed National Championship](#) for the Major College Football Division.
