The **Major College Football Division 90 (MCFD)** is a football only Division based on the former **Power 5** Conferences and is limited to 90 teams divided into 10 Conferences of 9 Teams each. The new emphasis on Student safety and Academics results in the change to an 11 game [Regular Season](#) over 12 weeks ending the Saturday after Thanksgiving that consists of 3 non-Conference games scheduled with MCFD opponents only and 8 Conference Games to determine the 10 Conference Champions and 6 Second Place teams invited to the 16 team Playoff. The [10 former FCS](#) teams added during the 2012 thru 2017 seasons will be dropped along with [30 Cupcake](#) teams from the former **Group of Five** Conferences.

There will be a maximum of 6 Regular Season home games for the [Best 45](#) former Power 5 Conference teams with the highest winning percentage the previous 8 years while the remaining 45 MCFD teams will have 5 home games during the Regular Season. There will be an extra home game for 8 Conference Champion Playoff teams. Every team will have 4 Conference home and 4 Conference away games every season.

Only 44 teams will be invited to the 4 Round 16 team [National Championship Playoff Series \(NCPS\)](#) and the 20 Bowl game [Post Season Bowl Competition \(PSBC\)](#). Bowl Eligible teams must have 6 or more wins and finish in at least 5<sup>th</sup> place with each Conference guaranteed 4 Bowl invitations. The 12 Teams eliminated in Rounds 1 & 2 of the Playoff will play in the Level I or II Post Season Bowl games.

The 4 Round, 16 team [National Championship Playoff Series \(NCPS\)](#) begins with 8 on-site home Elimination Games the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday in December. Then the Round 2 Quarter-Finals will be 4 Bowl Games on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in December. The 2 Semi-Final Bowl Games will be played on the 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday in December or 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday in January (except January 1<sup>st</sup>) and the National Championship Game will be played on the first Saturday after January 4<sup>th</sup>.
