

# NCAA 2016 - Major College Football Division

## The 9 former FCS Patsy Teams

The 2015 Regular Season of the NCAA Division 1 FBS featured 128\* teams with unequal status in 10 Conferences of unequal status, size and strength of programs. This will be fixed by the [Perfect Playoff Plan 16](#) that will reorganize the FBS into a new football only **Major College Football Division (MCFD)** with the 99 strongest teams in 11 Conferences with Equal Status, Size and Strength of their Programs.

This requires a consolidation that drops the weakest 29 teams. First dropping the 9 FCS teams added since 2012 because of the [No Patsy Rule](#), and the [20 Cupcakes](#) (\*) with the weakest records overall.

The 9 former FCS patsy teams have not been able to compete with the FBS teams and especially the Power 5 Conference teams. Their 2015 total combined record against Power 5 Teams was 0 - 14 and against the 90 teams for the **Major College Football Division** was only 4 - 31 (.114 win percentage).
